

RACE REGULATIONS

FIEMME ULTRA SKY 2026

ATPower Team sports associations organizes Fiemme Ultra Sky (FUSKY), ultra sky running race, on 3rd and 4th October, 2026. The race starts and finishes in Cavalese.

Fiemme Ultra Sky consists of four distances:

- Fiemme Sky Extreme 120K: distance 119.9 km and elevation gain 7,578 m
- Fiemme Sky Ultra 80K: distance 77.0 km and elevation gain 4,957 m
- Fiemme Sky Marathon 55K: distance 52.5 and elevation gain 3,120 m
- Fiemme Sky Race 30K: distance 29.9 km and elevation gain 1,715 m

Distances and elevations were measured using territory maps and GPS devices. Incongruities may occur in case of measurements done using different calibration devices.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Every participant needs:

- to be properly prepared for this kind of race, to know the Alpine territory and its difficulties;
- To be able to manage and solve potential problems that may arise during the race. Participants must be able to deal by themselves with the climatic adversities that they may find in the mountain: night darkness, rain, snow, cold temperature and fog;
- To be able to manage mental and physical crisis;
- To respect other participants, the territory and the volunteers on site for support and help.

OUR TERRITORY

To respect and to care for the environment around us is mandatory.

It is forbidden to litter and to damage the surrounding ecosystem.

Do not stain the path signs, peak crosses, huts. Keep in mind that you are a guest on the mountain.

REGISTRATIONS

To register to one of the FUSKY races it is mandatory:

- to be aware of the elevation and the distance that you choose and to be mentally and physically prepared to complete it;
- to be 18 years old or older on the day of the race;
- to have of a valid medical certificate for competitive sports (Art. 5 D.M. 18/2/82) specific to one of the following disciplines: ATHLETICS, CYCLING, SKI MOUNTAINEERING or ALPINE SKIING, CROSS COUNTRY SKIING; participants of non-Italian nationality must submit the medical certificate for foreigners, which will be provided by the organizer at this [link](#);
- To be able to manage in semi-self sufficiency the race tracks, even during the night;
- To be able to complete the chosen race in any weather condition (hot or cold temperature, rain, fog or snowfall);
- To be able to manage fatigue, muscular or joint pain and small wounds;
- To understand that mountain running requires a strong ability to adapt to the track;
- To understand that the organizing committee does not have to solve the runner's issues but to guarantee the safety of the track.

IMPORTANT NOTE

We strongly recommend using a device equipped with GPS functionality, onto which you can download the official race route updated the day before the competition.

Furthermore, we strongly recommend that you have a good ability to read the tracks on this device, this is crucial for the your safety and that of others. The mountain should never be underestimated.

To register to the FUSKY races you need to sign up to the Italian Skyrunning Federation (FISKY): you will need to enroll for a daily membership if you do not own an annual membership. To sign up for an annual membership you can request it to ATPower Team (atpowerteam@gmail.com).

Registrations open on **14th FEBRUARY 2026** and close on **20th SEPTEMBER 2026** or at bib depletion.

BIB COLLECTION

You can collect your bib at the bib distribution point in the Palafiemme in Cavalese on 2nd, 3rd and 4th October 2026 as follows:

Any changes to the race number collection will be announced closer to the event.

When collecting the bibs, all athletes participating in the 120K, 80K and 55K distances will have their mandatory equipment checked. Random checks will be carried out on athletes participating in the 30K race.

It is NOT allowed to collect the bib on behalf of other athletes.

It is permitted, by means of a [signed proxy](#) with a copy of the identity card, to collect only the race pack in the event that an athlete with a valid registration is unable to participate.

ENTRY CANCELLATION, RACE CHANGE, ENTRY TRANSFER

If the registered athlete cannot participate, please send a cancellation request to fusky@evodata.it.

- Cancellation requested before and on 31/08/2026: 70% entry fee refund or entry transfer to the next year race.
- Cancellation requested from 01/09/2026 to 20/09/2026: it is possible to transfer the entry to next year race only with a medical certificate that states the impossibility of the athlete to compete in the race.
- Requests received from 21/09/2026 onwards cannot be considered and will not be subject to any refund, transfer or postponement. Athletes will be entitled to collect their race packs in person or by proxy.

Up to 31/08/2025 and only in case of bib availability, the entry can be transferred from one race to another

- To transfer the entry to a longer race the athlete will be asked to pay the price difference following the price time table
- To transfer the entry to a shorter race, no refund will occur.

It is possible to transfer the entry to another athlete (change fee € 5,00). The request must be sent to fusky@evodata.it.

START TIMETABLE

All four races will start in via Bronzetti in Cavalese following the timetable:

- 120k Saturday 3rd October 2026 at 05:00
- 80k Saturday 3rd October 2026 at 07:00
- 55k Saturday 3rd October 2026 at 09:00
- 30k Sunday 4th October 2026 at 08:00

BRIEFING

Race briefing (120k, 80k, 55k) will take place on Friday 2nd October 2026 at at 07:00 PM at the Palafiemme in Cavalese (bib distribution point).

All athletes must be present at the start area 15 minutes prior to the start time for any last-minute updates.

30k race: the race briefing and the equipment check will take place 15 minutes prior to the start.

TRACK SIGNALIZATION

The track is signaled with reflective ribbons and arrow signals. It is forbidden to misplace the ribbons and signals. In order to respect our mountain, permanent marking will not be used. For the same reason athletes should not throw any rubbish on the ground.

If you find yourself for a long period of time with no ribbons or track indicators, you are on the wrong track. Go back to the right track.

SEMI-SELF SUFFICIENCY

FUSKY is a semi-self-sufficiency race. The athlete must manage difficult situations, problems or crisis completely by herself/himself.

The mandatory equipment list can be found in the equipment paragraph. Athletes must bring it along the whole race. Athletes will be asked to show the equipment to the volunteers at the checkpoints on the track, with no resistance. Disqualification will immediately occur in case of missing equipment or no collaboration by the athlete.

Aid stations will provide the athletes with beverages and food (if provided). The athlete will fill their water bottles and eat being aware that he will not get any help until the next aid station. Food must be consumed at the aid station.

Athletes cannot get physical assistance and be accompanied by a non-competing person between stations.

External assistance is allowed exclusively in reserved zones and exclusively for **Fiemme Sky Extreme 120k** and **Fiemme Sky Ultra 80k**. Reserved zones are located at the aid stations in Passo di Pampeago and at the sports field in Varena. Assistance may be carried out by one person. Massages can be performed. No medical assistance is allowed. Medical operators will be present in case of need.

Rest and sleep are only allowed on the track: it is forbidden to leave the track or sleep on vehicles.

External assistance is not allowed for **Fiemme Sky Marathon 55k** and **Fiemme Sky Race 30k**.

Dogs or other animals are not allowed during the race.

Immediate disqualification will occur in case of semi-self-sufficiency rules violation.

AID STATIONS

Amount of aid stations and their position are indicated on the chosen race page on the website (fiemmeultrasky.com). Only athletes with bib are allowed in the aid stations.

Station aids provide food and drinks to be consumed in the station aid. Beverages, water and mineral salts are available to fill the athlete's personal bottles. Drinks will be served in the athlete's own glasses or bottles. For environment reasons, no disposable glasses will be available.

The athlete must be aware of carrying enough food and drink along until the next station.

Fiemme Sky Extreme 120k and **Fiemme Sky Ultra 80k** provide two reserved zones where warm meal distribution will be organized. The athlete must have her/his own dish and cutlery. The zones will be located in Passo di Pampeago and at Base Vita at the sports field in Varena. One external person per athlete is allowed to give assistance in the zones.

MANDATORY AND ALLOWED EQUIPMENT

For their own safety, all athletes must carry the mandatory equipment during the entire race. Mandatory equipment checks are carried out at the bib distribution and on the track by the event personnel. No athlete is allowed to resist the check. In case of missing equipment or fighting the check, immediate disqualification will occur. Mandatory equipment's aim is the athlete's safety.

The athlete's backpack must be the same at the bib distribution, at the start and the finish.

Organizing committee has the unquestionable power to modify the mandatory equipment list depending on the weather conditions. In addition to the mandatory equipment, the organizing committee can add a COLD KIT or a WARM KIT to ensure the athlete's safety. Potential modifications to the mandatory equipment lists will be communicated the days prior to the event via newsletter, social media and information posts at the bib distribution.

STANDARD MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

For **Fiemme Sky Marathon 55k, Fiemme Sky Ultra 80k and Fiemme Sky Extreme 120k**

- Backpack
- Minimum 1 liter water supply
- Personal glass or mug, 150 ml minimum capacity
- Emergency food
- Whistle
- Mobile phone. It must be on and charged for the whole race. The emergency contact must be saved. IT IS NOT PERMITTED TO KEEP THE TELEPHONE IN AIRPLANE-MODE. ATHLETES FOUND WITH THEIR PHONE IN AIRPLANE MODE WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED.
- Power bank (**except for Fiemme Sky Marathon 55k**)
- Emergency cash to buy food
- Trail running technical shoes
- Long pants or leggings
- Long-sleeved t-shirt or arm-warmers
- Windproof gloves
- Waterproof jacket with hood with waterproof membrane, minimum 10,000 water columns
- Emergency survival blanket (minimum 2 x 1.4 m)
- Headlamp with spare battery
- Emergency elastic bandage
- Bib. The bib must not be covered during the race.
- Personal bowl and cutlery to get the warm meal at the main aid stations (**except for Fiemme Sky Marathon 55k**)
- ID or passport

Only for Fiemme Sky Race 30k

- Waterproof jacket with hood with waterproof membrane, minimum 10,000 water columns
- Trail running technical shoes
- Personal glass or mug, 15 ml minimum capacity
- Bib. The bib must not be covered during the race.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

- GPS device with official race track, updated the day before the race (**highly recommended**)
- Cap or bandana
- Sunglasses
- Mineral salts
- Trekking poles

ADDITIONAL WARM KIT

- Sunscreen lotion
- Sahara cap or any combination that covers the back of the neck
- 1,5 liter water reserve

ADDITIONAL COLD KIT

- warm long-sleeved t-shirt
- Warm long pants
- Warm beanie
- Warm gloves
- Running crampons

ALLOWED MATERIAL

Trekking poles are allowed and if needed they must be carried for the whole race.

It is possible to listen to music using earphones. Bone conduction earphones are recommended in order to always be alert during the race. In any case the earphones must be removed on town roads, at crossroads and aid stations.

EQUIPMENT CHECK

Each athlete must undergo the equipment check.

An equipment check station will be set up at the bib distribution. The athlete must collect the bib with their race backpack. Unexpected equipment check can happen during the race and at the finish.

BIB

The bib is strictly personal. It must be worn on the front of the body and must remain visible during the entire race. It cannot be modified and cannot be cut. It must remain intact as collected. Disqualification will occur in case of these rules violations.

AID STATION (BASE VITA) BAG

Fiemme Sky Extreme 120k athletes will receive the bag at the bib collection. Athletes will only use the given bag. It must be firmly closed. Fragile items, glass items or trekking poles cannot be inserted in the bag.

The bag must be handed in at the bag collection point at the Palafiemme one hour before the start and no later than the start. Bags that will arrive at the collection point after the start time will not be taken to the aid station.

After the race the bag can be collected in Cavalese at the Info Point at Palafiemme.

Non-collected bags will not be sent.

BAG STORAGE IN THE ARRIVAL AREA

Bag storage is available at the Info Point at the entrance of Palafiemme. Bags can be stored 1 hour before each start and must be collected again by the runner after the race, no later than 5 p.m. on Sunday 4th October. Loose personal items will not be accepted. The bag must contain only the clothing necessary for changing after the race. Please do not include any valuables. The organizer will not be responsible for any theft or damage.

CHANGING ROOMS AND SHOWERS

After the race changing rooms and showers will be available for the athletes.

CUT-OFF TIMES

Cut-off times for 120k, 80k, 55k are organized as following:

- Passo Feudo
120 K at 1:00 pm on 3rd October 2026
80 K at 3:00 pm on 3rd October 2026
55 K at 5:00 pm on 3rd October 2026
- Stava (55 K only) 55 K at 10:00 pm on 3rd October 2026
- Base Vita Varena (80K e120K only) 120 K at 01:00 am on 4th October 2026
80 K at 03:00 am on 4th October 2026
- Malga Nuova Val Moena (120K only) 120 K at 09:00 am on 4th October 2026

The athletes reaching the cut-off time position or the finish line after the time limit must take off the bib and abandon the race. In case of need, the organization will provide the transfer to the finish area.

Those who will want to continue the race after the time limit has passed, may do so. The responsibility will not be in charge of the organization but of the athlete.

All races must be completed before 5:00 pm on Sunday 4th October.

Maximum race time: 120k: 36 hours; 80k: 24 hours; 55k: 15 hours; 30k: 9 hours

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE DURING THE RACE

Mountain rescue service operators will be present on the course and at the aid stations. Their position is organized to ensure immediate help if needed. The medical service personnel are always connected via radio with the operation centre in Cavalese.

If an athlete needs help or sees another athlete in need of help he/she must immediately call the emergency number (provided by the organization).

If the athlete in need is able to walk, it is mandatory that he/she reaches the nearest aid station to get help.

The medical assistance operators are allowed to force the athlete to use the mandatory equipment and to force the athlete to withdraw if he/she is not reputed able to continue the race.

WITHDRAWALS

The withdrawn athlete must go to the nearest aid station (it is possible to go back to the latest station) if he/she is able to walk.

The athlete will be driven to the start/finish area – with the exception of the Malga Lagorai refreshment point. Competitors who decide to withdraw at Malga Lagorai will have to walk a distance of approximately 5 km before being picked up by the organisation's shuttle bus.

The bib will serve to benefit the organization services.

If the athlete reaches the checkpoints after the time limit, he/she can be driven to the start/finish area.

DISQUALIFICATION

Disqualification can occur because of:

- Missing passage at a checkpoint
- Self-determined shortening of the race course
- Fighting the mandatory equipment check
- Missing mandatory equipment
- Abandoning the race
- Sleeping or getting on private vehicles
- Lack of assistance to an athlete in need
- Littering on the course (bins are present at the aid stations and must be used)
- Damaging things, plants, signals and everything that concerns the race organization
- Lacking respect to the volunteers

RESULTS AND PRIZES

First 5 women and first 5 men will be awarded and a general result list will be published.

CLAIMS

Any kind of claim regarding entries, regulations or track will be presented to the organizing committee via mail info@fiemmeultrasky.com within the entry deadline.

Any kind of claim during the event that may regard the course, irregularities by the athletes or else will be presented to the organizing committee via mail before the end of the event, i.e. 11:59 pm on 4th October, 2026.

Any claim regarding the results will be presented to the organizing committee via mail within three hours past the arrival of the athlete.

For any other kind of claim, the email must be sent within 48 hours past the end of the last race.

EXCEPTIONAL CONDITIONS

In case of bad weather, exceptional issues or any situation that may compromise the athletes' safety, the organizing committee can modify at any moment the start time, the courses, the aid stations positions, the checkpoint positions and any other aspect in order to ensure the athletes' safety and the correct ongoing of the events. Therefore, the organizing committee has the power and the right to:

- cancel one or more races
- modify the tracks
- Interrupt the races at any moment
- Modify the start day and time
- Modify the cut-off times

The suspension, postponement or cancellation of the event will not entitle competitors to any reimbursement of the entry fee.

RIGHTS FOR IMAGE

At the registration the athlete allows the organizing committee to use photos and videos of her/himself during every moment of the event and for future promotional purposes. The athlete allows the organization to transfer any media to its partners, including the creation of videos and images for promotional reasons.

Each competitor expressly and free of charge renounces the use of his/her image rights during his/her participation in Fiemme Ultra Sky as well as any recourse and/or action, in any form, against the organization, its members and its authorised partners, for the use made of his/her image without territorial or time limits.

POLITICAL EXPRESSION

Any proclamation, display or exhibition of political or religious messages or images during the entire event is forbidden.

RESPONSIBILITY DECLARATION

By registering to and participating in FUSKY the athlete accepts these regulations and possible modifications, including last-minute variations. Any changes, additions or notices will be published on the website, communicated to all registered participants and displayed at the bib distribution desk. Participation in the race implies acceptance of these regulations in all their parts and without any reservations. By registering, each participant undertakes to comply with them and releases the organizer from all civil and/or criminal liability for any possible accident, for damage caused to themselves or to persons and/or things which may occur before, during and after the event.

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
