WHY THIS INFORMATION

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter the "Regulation"), this page describes the methods of processing the personal data of users who consult the website www.reggiareggia.it

This disclosure does not concern other websites, pages or online services consulted through links on www.reggiareggia.it

OWNER OF THE TREATMENT

Following consultation of the aforementioned site, data relating to identified or identifiable natural persons may be processed.

PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF THE TREATMENT

The personal data indicated on this page are processed by the Company by means of IT/telematic tools for purposes strictly necessary for consulting the site www.reggiareggia.it as well as for purposes connected and/or instrumental to the consultation itself.

Any personal data provided by users who submit requests by sending messages to the Company's contact addresses or by filling in the contact forms on the Company's website are used for the sole purpose of providing the necessary answers.

The data will be processed using tools and with methods aimed at ensuring the confidentiality and security of the data, in compliance with the provisions of the Regulation and in compliance with the national legislation in force on the matter. Specific security measures are observed to prevent data loss, illicit or incorrect use and unauthorized access.

The processing of personal data for the aforementioned purposes does not require consent as it is necessary to allow consultation of the site www.reggiareggia.it

TYPES OF DATA PROCESSED

Navigation data

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers and terminals used by users, the addresses in URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) notation of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's IT environment.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed for the purpose of:

- obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors per hour or day, geographical areas of origin, etc.);
- check the correct functioning of the services offered.

The navigation data does not persist for more than seven days (except for any need for the investigation of crimes by the judicial authorities).

Data communicated by the user

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of messages to the Company's contact addresses, as well as the compilation and forwarding of the forms on the Company's website, involve the acquisition of the sender's contact details, necessary to respond, as well as all the personal data included in the communications.

Specific information will be published on the pages of the Company's website set up for the provision of certain services.

Cookies and other tracking systems

No cookies are used for user profiling, nor are other tracking methods used.

Instead, session cookies (non-persistent) are used strictly limited to what is necessary for safe and efficient navigation of the sites. The storage of session cookies in the terminals or browsers is under the control of the user, whereas on the servers, at the end of the HTTP sessions, information relating to the cookies remains recorded in the service logs, with retention times in any case not exceeding seven days like other navigation data.

DATA RECIPIENTS

The personal data collected is also processed by the Company's personnel, who act on the basis of specific instructions provided in relation to the purposes and methods of the processing itself.

RIGHTS OF INTERESTED PARTIES

The interested parties have the right to obtain from the Company, in the cases envisaged, access to their personal data and the rectification or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the treatment that concerns them or to oppose the treatment (articles 15 and following of the regulation). Requests can be submitted by contacting the Data Controller at the addresses indicated above.

RIGHT TO COMPLAINT

Interested parties who believe that the processing of personal data referring to them carried out through this site occurs in violation of the provisions of the Regulation, have the right to lodge a complaint with the Privacy Guarantor, as provided for by art. 77 of the Regulation itself, or to take the appropriate judicial offices (art. 79 of the Regulation).
