

PRIVACY DISCLAIMER

ex art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter "GDPR")

Dear Sir/Madame,

pursuant to article 13 of the GDPR, we inform you that the Asd Maratoneti Cittadellesi - with headquarters in Piazza Martiri del Grappa 1, 35013 Cittadella (PD) - as Data Controller, will process - for the purposes and with the methods of reported below - the personal data provided by you during the registration process.

In particular, the Asd Maratoneti Cittadellesi will process the following personal data:

- a) personal and identification data (name and surname, date and place of birth, residence and/or domicile address, telephone, email address, tax code);
- b) bank details;
- c) curricular data.

Pursuant to the aforementioned legislation, the processing of your personal data will be based on the principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and the protection of your privacy and your rights.

1. Legal basis and purpose of processing

The processing is based on your consent and is aimed at:

- 1.1 management of your registration request and accounting of the participation application;
- 1.2 sending information and/or advertising material relating to commercial and promotional initiatives, including from our Company's commercial partners.

The legal basis of the processing is constituted by the obligations established by national and community legislation as well as by the obligations deriving from the application for participation.

2. Treatment methods

The processing of your personal data will be carried out, also with the aid of electronic means, by means of the operations indicated in the art. 4 Code and art. 4 no. 2) GDPR and precisely: the processing of personal data may consist of the collection, recording, organisation, consultation, processing, modification, selection, extraction, comparison, use, interconnection, blocking, communication, cancellation and destruction of data.

3. Mandatory provision

The provision of data is mandatory to achieve the purposes referred to in point 1.1 and any refusal to provide the data will make it impossible to proceed with completing the registration process.

The provision of the data referred to in letter a) for the purposes referred to in points 1.2 is optional.

4. Scope of data communication

The staff specifically appointed by the Asd Maratoneti Cittadellesi may also become aware of your personal data in their capacity as "data processor", and may also be processed on behalf of our Company by external parties designated as Data Processors, in cases where the communication is necessary for the purposes illustrated above.

The personal data you provide may be communicated to organizations and public administrations for legal purposes and in general to subjects authorized by law to request the data.

The personal data you provide will not be disclosed.

5. Transfer of data abroad

5.1 Personal data is stored on servers located within the European Community. In any case, it is understood that the Owner, if necessary, will have the right to move the servers even outside the EU. In this case, the Data Controller hereby ensures that the transfer of non-EU data will take place in compliance with the applicable legal provisions and in particular those referred to in Title V of the GDPR or following the signing of standard contractual clauses approved and adopted by the Commission. European.

5.2 Outside of the hypotheses referred to in point 5.1, your data will not be transferred outside the EU

6. Data retention period

Your data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were acquired and in accordance with the specific legal provisions in this regard, according to the limitation period of the rights arising from the management of your registration request.

7. Data controller

The data controller is the Asd Maratoneti Cittadellesi with registered office in Piazza Martiri del Grappa 1, 35013 Cittadella (PD), in the person of the Legal Representative pro-tempore.

8. Rights of the interested party

With regard to all personal data processed, you may exercise the rights provided for by the articles. 15 and following of the Regulation (right of access, rectification, cancellation or limitation, opposition and data portability) within the limits and conditions set out therein, through a specific request to be addressed by registered letter to the Data Controller.

You have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority in the matter, the Guarantor for the protection of personal data.

Finally, we inform you that consent to the processing of personal data in the manner and for the purposes illustrated above is optional. In the event of your refusal of consent, our Company will not be able to process your personal data, but only use them in compliance with the obligations established by law or other existing regulations, for the purpose of managing your registration application.
